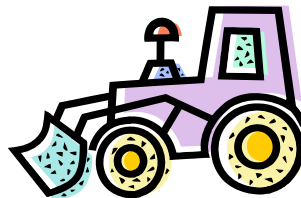

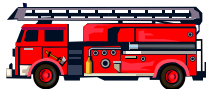
Police and Fire Services in School
